



COVID CAMP POLICIES

- Negative PCR test 3 days prior to arrival
- Negative PCR test 4 days after arrival
- We administered over 500 PCR and rapid tests
- Cabin participated in cohorts (pods) of 8-10 kids
- Added air flow to indoor locations
- Added UV lights to indoor locations
- Tents for outdoor dining: tables 6 feet apart
- Masking at all times, except when inside cabin or totally distanced from other cohorts
- Cabin activities instead of free elective program
- 2 cabins in the pool at a time with a volleyball net separating them
- Staff remained at camp for 7 weeks
- Each cabin had their own water cooler
- Closed all common bathrooms
- Absolutely no visitors
- Disinfected all highly touched areas at least 3 times a day
- Separated cabins for all camp night activities
- Limited shared supplies
- Daily screening logs with follow up rapid test if required
- Staggered drop off and pick up times
- Medical triaging was done completely outside, unless diagnosis warranted more intensive care (i.e. on-going cancer treatment, etc.)
- Deliveries were limited, drivers were required to mask and stay distanced from campers, a delivery door was added to our Dining Hall for separate access
