



WHAT IS THE BEAD GAME?

The Bead Game is a large-scale version of “Heads or Tails,” played with strands of beads. Participants pay an entry fee to receive bead necklaces (limit 10 per person).

Everyone stands and chooses “heads” or “tails” each round by placing their hands on their head or rear. The host flips a coin, and those who guessed correctly keep their beads, while those who guessed incorrectly give up one strand.

When a participant loses all their beads, they sit down. Rounds continue until only one person remains standing.

The final person wins free registration to next year’s COCAcon.

\$5 for one strand of beads, \$10 for 5 strands, \$20 for 10 strands
